Submission of Application:

Candidates are to apply and submit their applications strictly through online mode by clicking on the **“Online Application”** icon appearing in the website viz. www.meghalayahighcourt.nic.in.

Applications received through any other mode shall not be accepted and will be summarily rejected.

For candidates applying for the first time through online mode, a one-time registration process is required to enable them to apply against the advertised vacancies/posts. Kindly read the instructions on the web page carefully before applying online. The last date for receiving online applications is on 30th June, 2024 by 1700 hours.

Candidates who have already registered with the Recruitment Portal may log in and apply directly against the advertised vacancies/posts of their choice.

Payment for online applications

Application Fees for the said posts for general applicants is **Rs.400/- (Rupees Four hundred)** only and **Rs.200/- (Rupees Two hundred)** only for **Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe**. Candidates may pay using the following modes:

1. ATM Cum Debit Card issued by State Bank of India or Net Banking of State Bank of India's account-holders. Please select ePayment and select State Bank of India in the Meghalaya Portal Page and proceed for payment.
2. Cash payment at any branch of SBI using eChallans: Candidates may also pay by Cash at any branch of SBI. For cash payments using eChallan, select Payment across Bank Counter and generate the eChallan. Take a print-out of the same and make the required payments. Payments must be made within 3 days from the last date of receipt of application. The amount once deposited shall not be refunded or adjusted against any other purpose.

A candidate for appointment to the High Court service who is not in permanent Government Service must not be more than 32 (Thirty-two) years of age in case of General Category candidates and 37 (thirty-seven) years of age in case of Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe candidates at the time of his/her application. No application shall be entertained from a person whose age is less than 18 (eighteen) years.

Candidates who are already in the Government Service have to mention properly in the column of the online application page whether the post is on contractual basis or permanent/regular.

Age will be calculated from the date fixed for receiving the applications.

2. The last date for submission of applications shall be on **30th June, 2024 by 1700 hours**.
